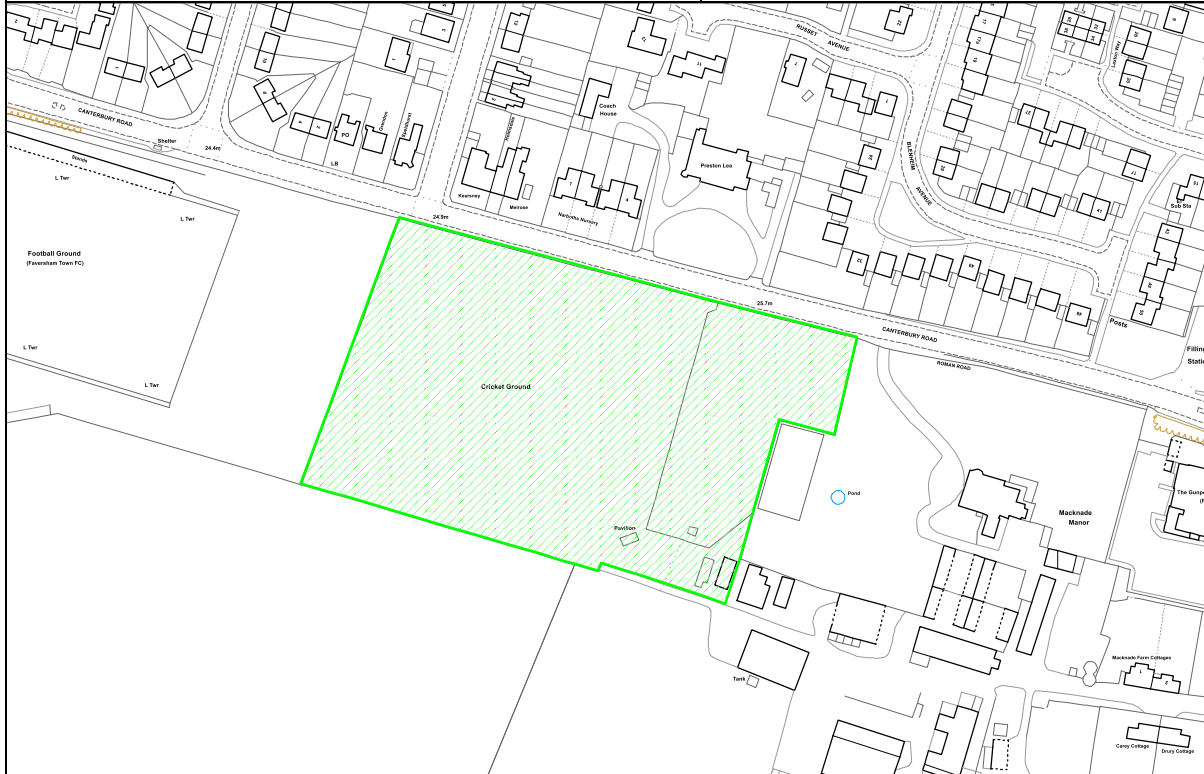

Is the green space:	
In reasonably close proximity to the community it serves?	Yes – within Faversham town.
Demonstrably special to a local community and of particular local significance? (For example, because of its beauty, historic significance, recreational value, tranquillity, or richness of its wildlife.)	Yes – this land forms a cricket ground which subsequently holds significant recreation value for the community.
Local in character and not an extensive tract of land?	Yes – modest and contained.
Would designation conflict with the overall Local Plan strategy for delivering sustainable development?	Yes – this land is within a large, proposed development allocation in the Local Plan Review. While the precise layout of this allocation is yet to be determined, this land is unlikely to be remain in its current form.
Could designation endure beyond the end of the plan period?	No – as above.
Is the land already protected by another type of designation? If so, would any additional local benefit be gained by its designation as a Local Green Space?	The land is an existing LGS designation which is proposed for de-designation.
Designate as a Local Green Space?	No – de-designate.
