Proposed Designation 2026

Whereas

1. Swale Borough Council (hereinafter called “the Council”) as Local Planning Authority have considered whether (Swale Areas of Special Control of Advertisements) order should be designated in respect of land specified in Schedule 1 in accordance with Regulation 20 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended).
2. The Council have decided that the land specified in Schedule 1 should be included in the area.

Now Therefore the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 220 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and the said Regulation 20.

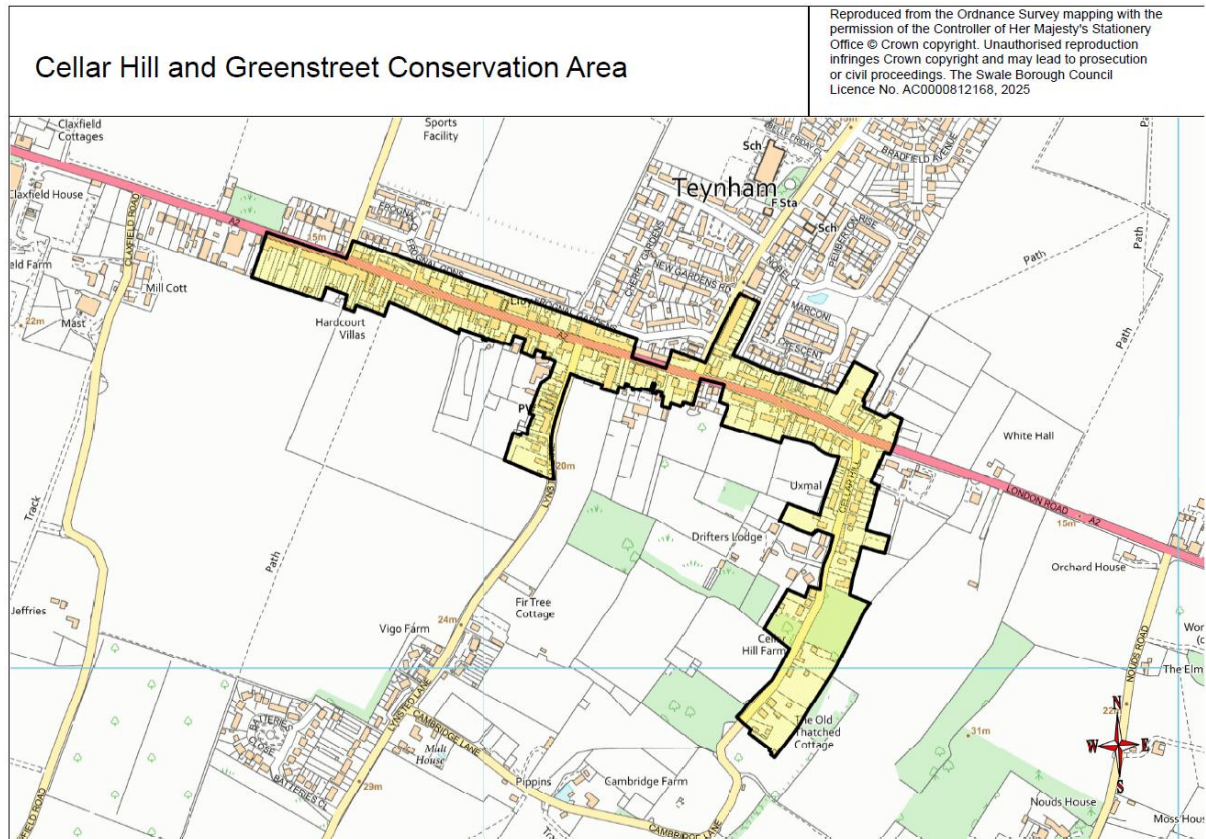
Do hereby order

1. That all the land specified in Schedule 1 and shown in colour shall be designated as Area of Special Control for the purposes of the said regulations.
2. That this Order may be cited as Swale Area of Special of Advertisements Order 2026.

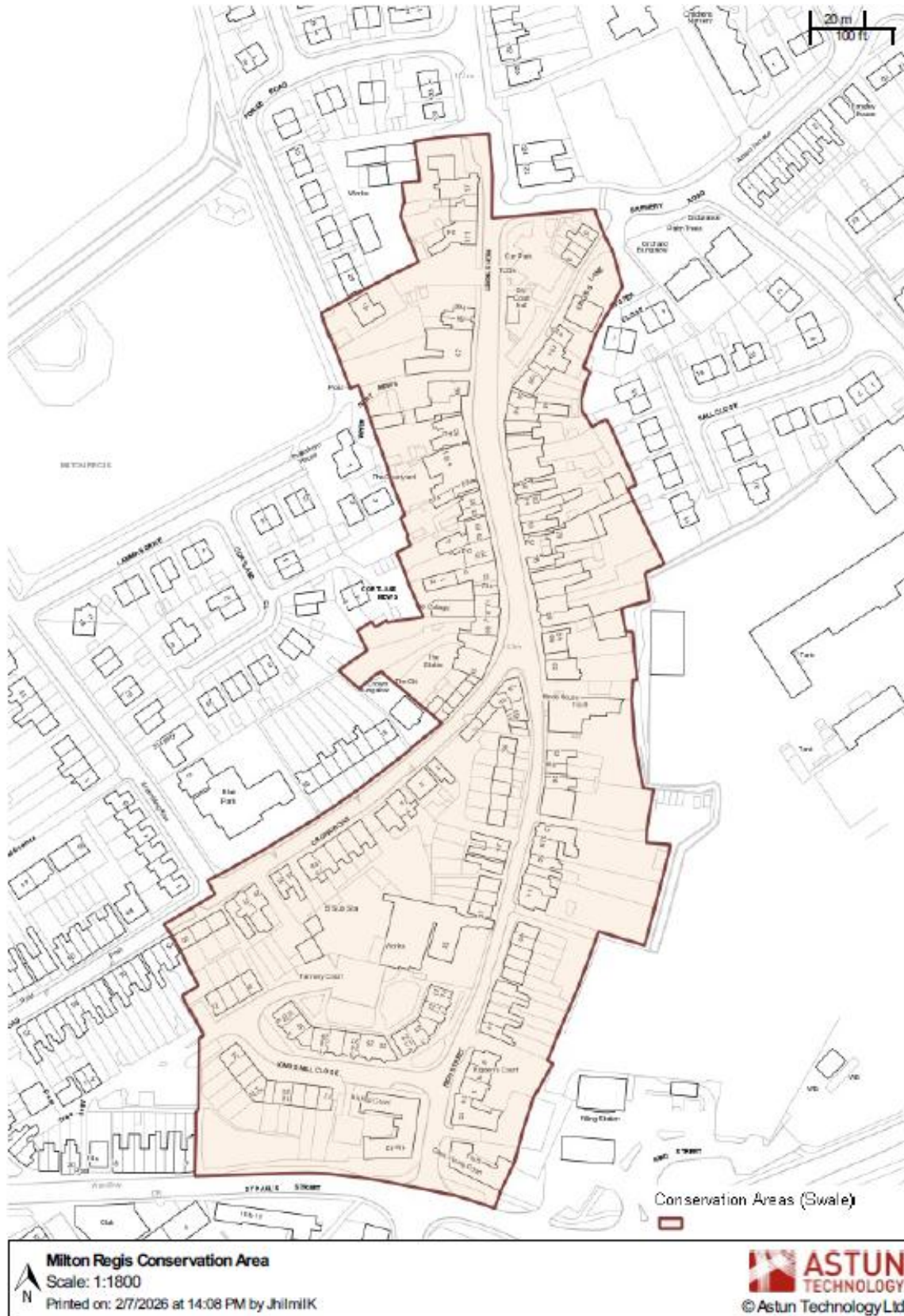
a. Cellar Hill & Greenstreet

The entire Conservation Area as shown in the map with yellow colour



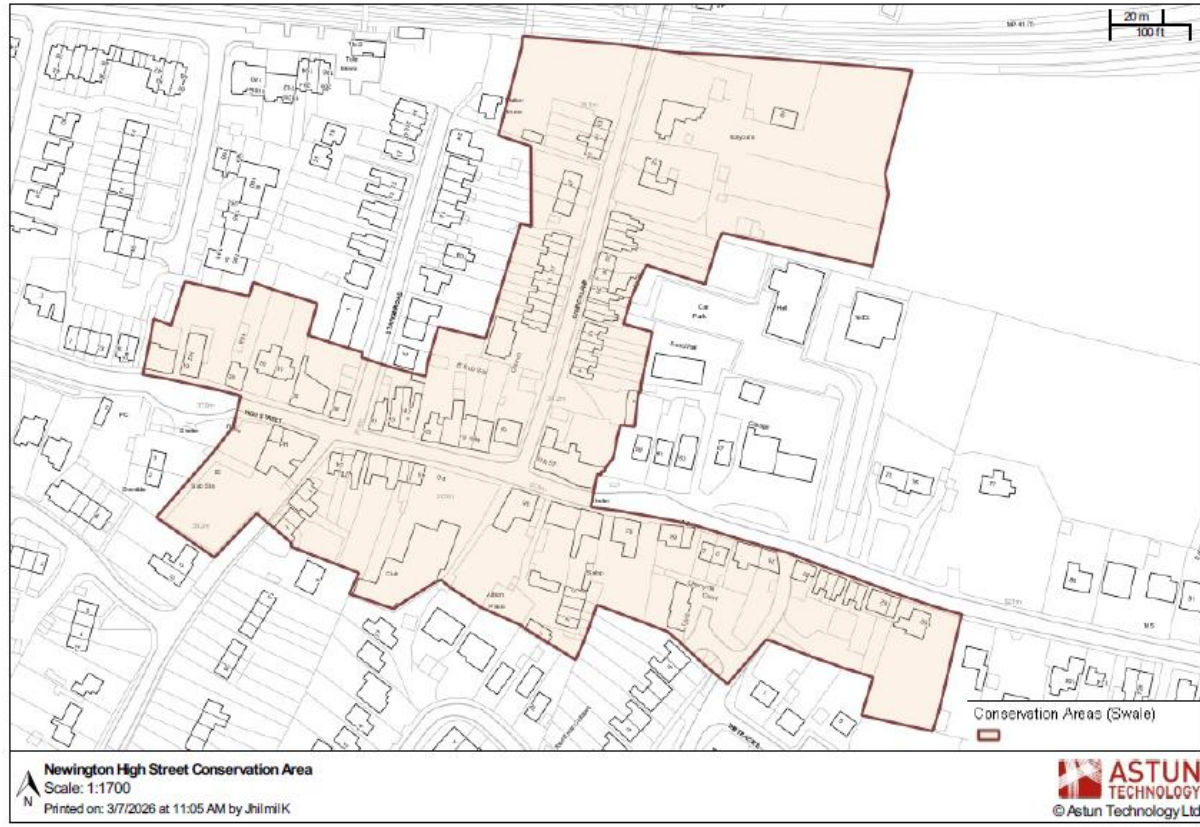
b. Milton Regis

The entire Conservation Area as shown in the map with yellow colour



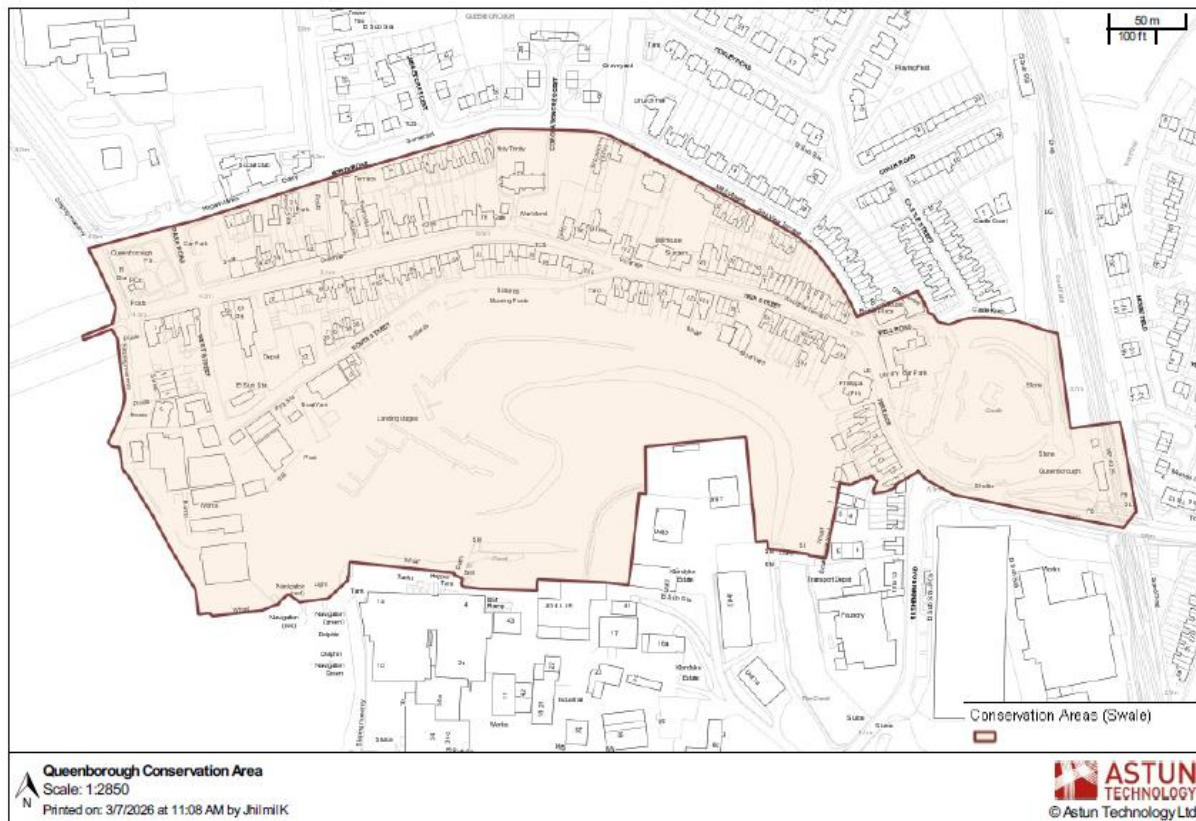
c. Newington High Street

The entire Conservation Area as shown in the map with yellow colour



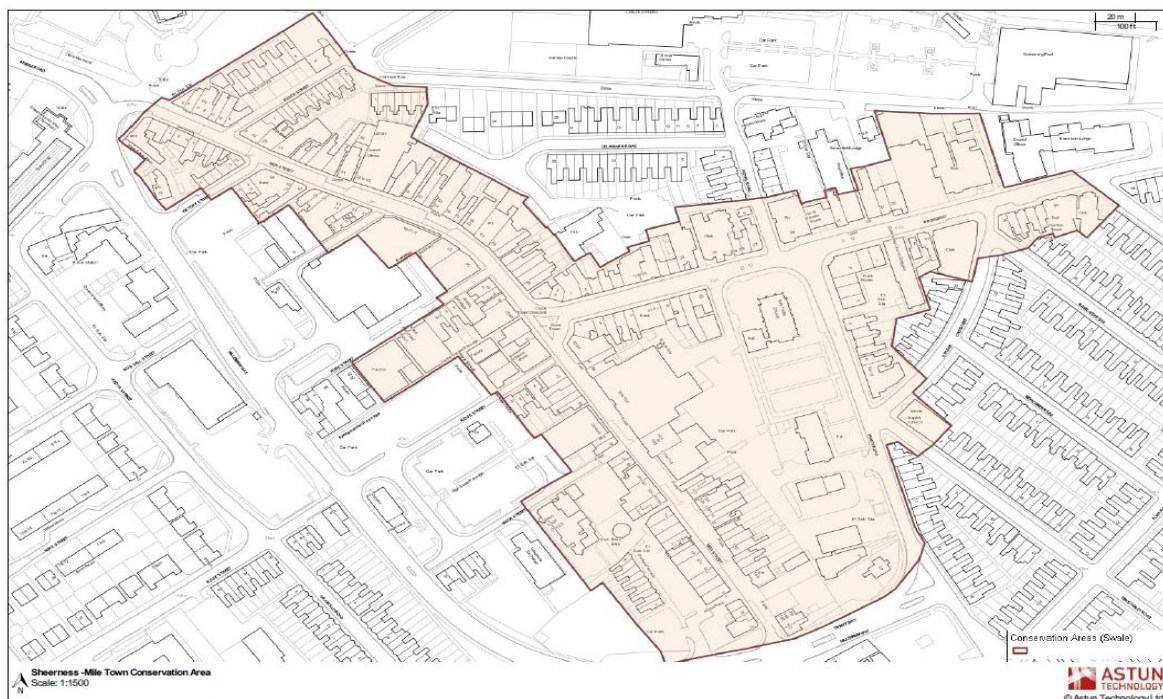
d. Queenborough

The entire Conservation Area as shown in the map with yellow colour



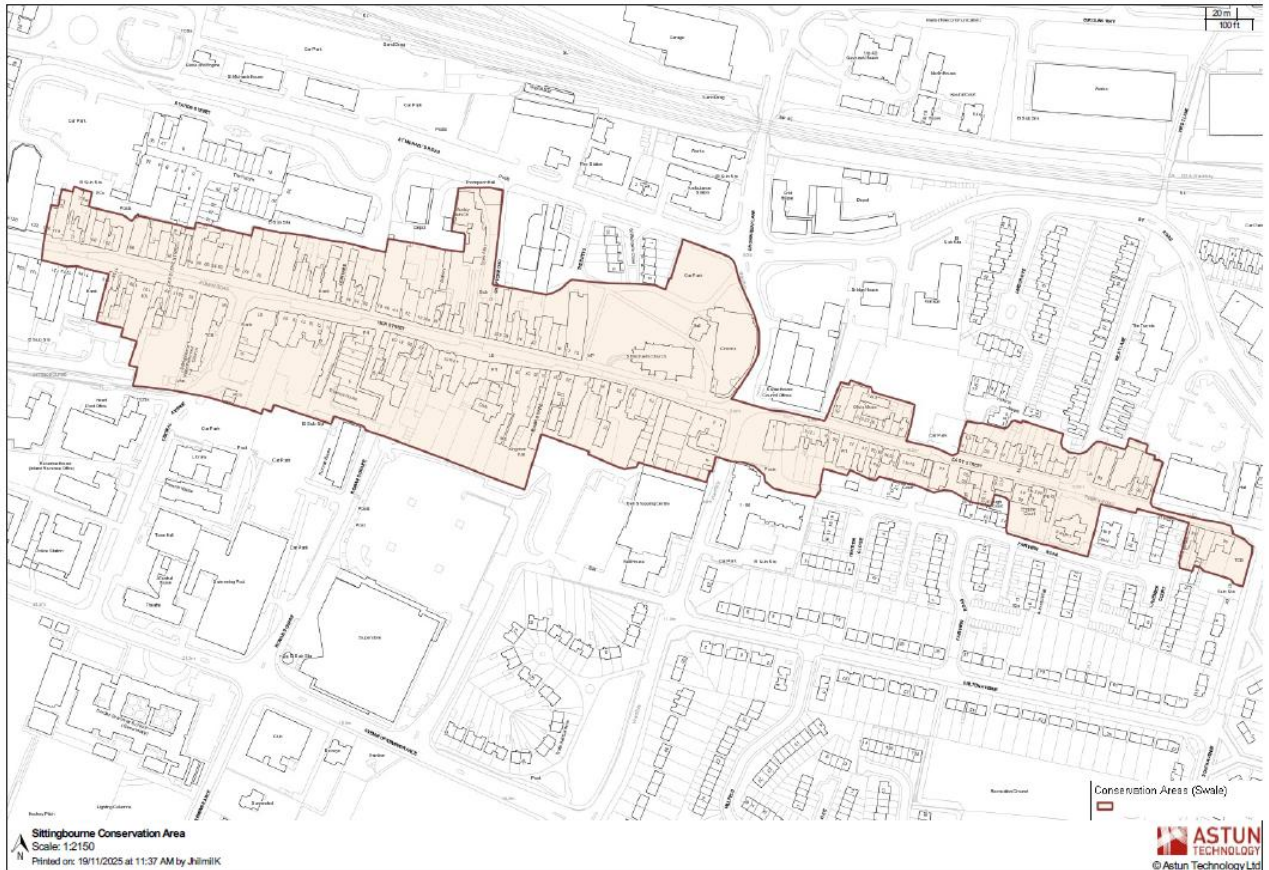
e. Sheerness Mile Town

The entire Conservation Area as shown in the map with yellow colour



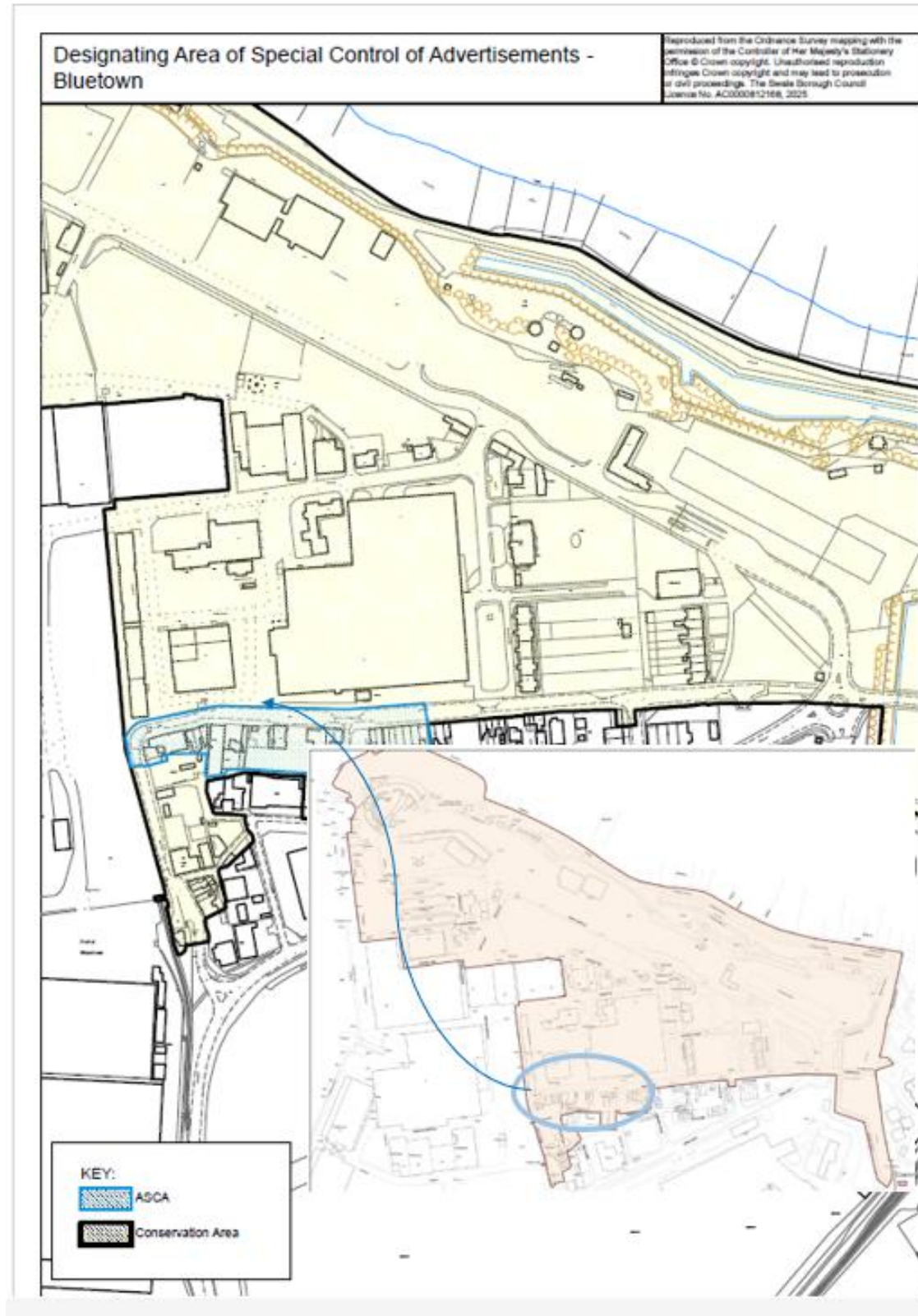
f. Sittingbourne
